

Donald Kent ^{11/} Services Held ^{10/}₇₂

Donald P. Kent, 60, of 312 Mill St., Brooklyn, died Friday evening at Grinnell General Hospital.

The son of Jim and Sadie Hefner Kent, he was born March 12, 1912, in Boone. He married Mildred Collum Jan. 17, 1935, in Victor. The couple lived in Belle Plaine following their marriage, then moved to Chicago.

Mr. Kent was a brakeman and conductor for a number of years for the Chicago & North Western Railroad. He retired in 1963 because of poor health, and was then employed by Burns Security. In May of 1970 they moved to Brooklyn. Mr. Kent was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church and the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen.

He is survived by his wife Mildred; one son, Donald Eugene of Hoffman Estates, Ill.; one daughter, Karen Acvedo of Youngstown, Ohio; and nine grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents.
