**Rites held for
Allen Kies, 72**

Funeral services for Allen Kies, 72, of Malcom were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the United Methodist Church in Malcom. Mr. Kies died Sunday, Aug. 1, at Grinnell General Hospital. Officiating at the services was the Rev. John Maze. Organist was Mrs. Sonny Schneekloth. He was married to Velma Bauman on May 3, 1929, at Viborg, S.D. A retired hardware store owner, Mr. Kies operated businesses in Hartwick, Malcom and Brooklyn.
