

Rites held for Mr. Kingsland

George Kingsland, 79 of Harvey, Ill., a native of Malcom, died Friday, May 27.

Funeral services were conducted on Tuesday, May 31, at Brown's Funeral Home, with the Rev. Clifford Baumann officiating.

The son of Jesse and Grace Shifflett Kingsland, he was born Jan. 20, 1904, at Malcom.

He graduated from Grinnell High School in 1922 and from De Paul University in Chicago in 1931, receiving his master's degree in 1938.
