Mrs. Kreager services held

Glen L. Kreager, 94, died Monday, Oct. 21, at Heritage Manor in Newton.

Funeral services for Mrs. Kreager were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the First Presbyterian Church in Newton, with the Rev. William Calhoun officiating. Burial was in Newton Union Cemetery, with the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Sumner E. and Margaret I. McConkey Gates, she was born on Dec. 31, 1890. She was a graduate of Newton High School and also attended normal college.

On Aug. 27, 1913, she was married to William M. Kreager. She lived most of her

life on a farm four miles northeast of Newton.

Mrs. Kreager was an 81-year member of the First Presbyterian Church and was active in the Women's Association of the church. She was also a member of the Emanon Club and the Newton Women's Club.

Survivors are a son, Merle C. Kreager of Newton, four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband; one daughter Irene L. Kreager; and one son, Max W. Kreager.
