Max Kreager services held

Max W. Kreager, 67, of Newton, former manager of the Poweshiek-Jasper Farm Service Co. here and manager of American Federal Savings and Loan in Newton until his retirement in 1981, died Fri-

day, Sept. 23, at a Sandusky, Ohio, hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the First United Methodist Church in Newton, with burial at Newton Union Cemetery.

Mr. Kreager, who represented Jasper County in the Iowa House of Representatives from 1961 until 1964, was a former chairman of the Jasper County Republican Central Committee. He served for 13 years as a member of the Des Moines Area Community College Board and was past president of the Iowa Council of Area School Boards. He was also active in church affairs, having held numerous offices in the First United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Marjorie; two daughters, Mary Howell of Des Moines and Marsha Schroeder of Davenport; a brother, Merle Kreager of rural Newton; and his mother, Glen Kreager of Heritage Manor Nursing Home. He was preceded in death by his father, William Kreager, and a sister.
