Leonard H. Kriegel, 76, of 511 E. Seventh Street, Tama, died at Marshalltown Medical & Surgical Center Thursday morning, Sept. 4, 1986, where he had been a patient since the previous Tuesday. He had been in failing health a short period and his death was attributed to congenital heart failure and emphysema.

The Rosary was recited in the Chapel of Mason-Hand Funeral Home, Tama, at 7:30 Friday evening, led by Alan Prusha. Mrs. Robert Wilson and Mrs. Charles Duhacek were in charge of Mass offerings.
