

## Mrs. Charles LaKose Funeral Last Friday

Funeral services for Mrs. Charles LaKose, 64, were held last Friday morning at St. Patrick's church with the Rev. John T. Kennedy officiating at the requiem mass and delivering the funeral sermon.

Mrs. LaKose came to the United States in 1919 and was married to Charles P. LaKose Jan. 10, 1923, at St. Bridget's church in Victor.

She is survived by her husband; three daughters, Mrs. Lloyd (Bernadine) Hall, Mrs. Everett (Patricia) Seye and Mrs. Dale (Yvonne) Hawkins; and ten grandchildren. She also leaves two sisters, both of whom live in Belgium.
