Services Held for Larry Lanning, 70

Larry Lanning, 70, of Madrid, died Saturday night at Mercy Hospital in Des Moines after surgery.

Mr. Lanning was born in Lewis, Ind., to Mr. and Mrs. M. C. Lanning on June 11, 1900. He worked for the Bankers' Life Company during the Depression Years, after a period of employment with the State Banking Department.

Mr. Lanning began organizing the City State Bank of Madrid, Ia., in 1934. He was then employed at the Grinnell State Bank from about 1939 to 1945, living in the city of Grinnell for about two years before being employed at the bank.

In 1945, Mr. Lanning moved to Madrid. He was president of the City State Bank there for about 25 years, up to the time of his death.

He was an active member of many civic organizations including the Lions Club, the Masonic Lodge, and the American Legion. He was also the president of the Madrid Development Commission and a representative to the Central Iowa Planning and Zoning Commission.

Mr. Lanning is survived by his wife Virginia; two daughters, Mrs. Roy Walters of Mason City, Ia., and Mrs. R. H. Sundberg of Madrid; and four grandchildren.

Services for Larry Lanning were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Sundberg Funeral Home in Madrid, with the Rev. Lynn J. King of the United Church of Christ officiating. Interment was in the Hillsdale Cemetery.
