Allison E. Lannom, 43, of 1232 Main St., Grinnell, died at her home Wednesday, April 11. The cause of death was not known, pending a medical examiner's autopsy.

A memorial service was conducted at 10:30 a.m. Monday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. David Bowman, pastor of the United Church of Christ — Congregational, officiating. Organist was Joyce Wubbels, and eulogist was Dianne Latimer. Following cremation, burial was in Minden, Neb.
