Martha Appleby was born in Hugosund, Norway, Feb. 4, 1856. In 1868 she came to this county with her parents, brother and sisters and settled near New Sharon.

She had been married twice. One son, Roger Armstrong, survives the first marriage. To the second union five children were born: Anna, Mamie, Agnes, Karl and Rebecca. Of these all survive except Karl who died in infancy.

Besides these she took a real mother's place to her husband's five children, Mrs. C. U. Bell, Mrs. John Alertsen, Mrs. Jake Blankenfeld, now deceased; Carrie and Herman Larson.

She was a member of the Lutheran church and an active member of the Ladies' Aid. She had been in poor health for some time but had not been confined to her bed until the past two months.

Her death occurred Wednesday morning, October 23rd, at her home, seven miles southeast of Grinnell, and she was laid to rest in the Hazelwood cemetery Friday afternoon, Rev. J. M. Brown conducting the services.
