IN MEMORIAM.

Frank Ance, son of Henry and Abbie Clark Lawrence, was born in Grinnell, May 9th, 1873, and closed his life here on last Monday morning, June 27th, when a little more than twenty-five years old. He rendered cheerful service in his early years in all youthful helpfulness, and made himself of great value to his father in the Savings Bank before his graduation from the Grinnell High School, five years ago. Since then he has done much in the way of furnishing illustrations for Des Moines papers, and shown real tact and talent in this department of art. It was only a few days ago that he returned from Des Moines, with the knowledge that quick consumption was hastening life to its end. He declined rapidly.

Frank was of the second generation of earliest settlers in Grinnell, a dutiful son, a helpful brother, a noble youth, a sincere christian. Just entering manhood as he was, we would have given him a long life in which to bless an orphaned family and to serve the age, but one wiser than we has called him.
