Kellogg Rites Today For Samuel Leach

—Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) at the Kellogg Christian church for Samuel Leach, 66, who died at his home in Kellogg last Friday morning.

Mr. Leach had been a resident of Kellogg for the past 10 years.

Officiating at the services was the Rev. Charles Fry, pastor of the church. Burial was in Our Silent City cemetery.

Son of Freeman and Ellen Leach, he was born May 4th, 1895, at Kingfisher, Okla., and moved to Creston while still a child. He spent most of his life in that area until moving to Kellogg.

Mr. Leach was a barber and was educated in the Creston schools.
