

## OBITUARY

THOMAS E. LEE

Thomas Emanuel Lee, son of Ole and Ingeberg Lovig Lee, was born at Newburg on December 16, 1911, and died suddenly at the home of his parents in Grinnell on Friday evening, April 18, 1958, at the age of 46 years, four months, and two days.

He was baptized in the Lutheran faith at Grinnell. Mr. Lee received his education in the Newburg school, graduating with the class of 1930. He entered the carpentry business which he continued proficiently in Newburg and community all his life with the exception of the years spent in service.

Mr. Lee entered the service April 11, 1941, and was overseas with the United States army during the years 1942-45. He was a member of the American Legion and Eagles Lodge.

For three years prior to his death he was in poor health, having spent some time in hospitals at Iowa City and Washington, D.C.

His acquaintances knew Thomas Lee as a friendly man.

Survivors include his parents, four brothers, Harold of Gainsville, Fla., Orville with the Air Force in Alaska, Ivan of Berkeley, Calif., and Charles of Cedar Rapids, and one sister, Bernice Hauser of Kellogg.

Also surviving are 11 nephews and a host of friends throughout the community.
