Memorial services for Alice Thomas Leech, 66, of Cleveland, Ohio, formerly of Grinnell, were held April 13 in Cleveland.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David H. Thomas, she moved to Grinnell from Storm Lake with her family in 1925. She was graduated from Grinnell High School in 1929, attended Grinnell College, and was graduated from Miss Wood's Kindergarten School in Minneapolis, Minn., in 1934, and from Drake University in 1951.

She taught in Blairsburg, Vinton, Iowa City and Des Moines. From 1945 to 1949 she

was a floral designer at Bates Flowers here.

She had taught in the Mayfield, Ohio, school system for a number of years, retiring last year.
