Rites Friday for Mr. Light

Edgar C. "Ted" Light, 93, of St. Francis Manor, formerly of Malcom, died Tuesday at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services for Mr. Light were held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. I. P. Fitzpatrick, pastor of the Malcom United Presbyterian Church, officiating. Organist was Kathleen Hoffner. Burial was at Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom.

Pallbearers were Marvin Beck, Walter Beck, Walter Dee, Hiram Dee, Erwin Jordan, and Raymond Schlesselman.

The son of Thomas and Maude Ennis Light, he was born April 2, 1884, in Jackson Township. He was graduated

from Deep River High School in 1902, later teaching school for a few years.

On Jan. 18, 1911, he was married to Rachel Harriet Dee at Brooklyn. The couple farmed for many years near Deep River, later moving to the Malcom area to farm. Following their retirement, they moved into Malcom. Mr. Light had lived at St. Francis Manor since 1972.

Survivors include two sons, Ennis Light of Cedar Rapids and Dr. Ernest Light of Cambria, Calif.; three grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Rachel; a daughter, Mrs. Jay Harriette Young; and two sisters.
