## Neva Lincoln Services Held

Mrs. Neva Lincoln, 79, of Missoula, Mont., the widow of Arthur H. Lincoln, died in Missoula Saturday, June 8.

The daughter of Harry and Etta Ratcliff Russell, she was born Sept. 30, 1894 in the Sugar Creek area. She was married to Arthur H. Lincoln in November of 1914. They farmed in Poweshiek County for several years and had three children here. They lived in Grinnell for a few years before moving to Missoula. Mr. Lincoln died in 1958.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. George (Doris) Petaja of Bonner, Mont., and Mrs. Asher (Irene) Tanner of Missoula; a son, Donald, of California; nine grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; and a brother, Ralph Russell of Hot Springs, Mont. Mrs. Lincoln was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and one grandson, Ronald Tanner, who died in Vietnam in 1970.

Funeral services for Mrs. Lincoln were held June 11 in Missoula, with burial in the Missoula cemetery.
