

Rites held for Mr. Livingston

John Robert Livingston, 74, of Rockford, Ill., a native of Grinnell, died Sunday morning, Aug. 11, at St. Anthony's Hospital in Rockford.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at the Long-Klontz Funeral Home in Rockford, with burial in Sunset Memorial Gardens there. A memorial service was held at 10 a.m. Thursday at the United Methodist Church in Grinnell.

The son of W. Dale and Grace E. Livingston, he was born April 14, 1917, in Grinnell. He had lived in Peoria, Ill., before moving to Rockford in 1957.

On Nov. 26, 1949, he was married to Louise Burris in Chicago. Mr. Livingston formerly owned radio station WPEO in Peoria and later founded WJRL, now WYSE, in Rockford. He was a graduate of Grinnell High School and attended Grinnell College.

Survivors include his wife; one daughter Ann Afflerbaugh of Libertyville, Ill.; one grandson; and two brothers, David of Lake Elsmore, Calif., and Larry of Maroa, Ill. He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Phyllis Spader; and one brother, Dale Jr.
