RAYMAN D. LOGUE

Rayman D. Logue, 64, died at Marengo Hospital early Sunday morning. He served in the Iowa House of Representatives as a member from Iowa and Poweshiek Counties 1969-70 and 1973-74. He was a right-of-way agent for Iowa Electric Light and Power Company until his retirement in 1983, and he managed the Marengo division of IE from 1958 to 1967.

Survivors include his wife, Cleo; a son, Michael of Lewisville, Colo.; a daughter, Karee Roggentine of Louisville, Ky.; a sister, Lucille Wheeler of Cherokee; and five grandchildren.
