## Dorothy Lovig

Dorothy P. Strand Lovig, 91, of Springville, a native of Gilman, died at her home Thursday, July 1, following a lingering illness.

Funeral services will be conducted Tuesday at the United Methodist Church in Springville, with the Rev. Matt Miller officiating. Graveside services will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Prairie View Cemetery, Gilman.

She was the daughter of Theodore and Gladys Wallace Strand and was born Oct. 20, 1907, in Gilman. She was a 1927 graduate of Newburg High School.

She was married to Norris "Snipe" Lovig April 7, 1932, in Princeton, Mo. They farmed near State Center and later near Marion. In the early 1950s, they moved to Whittier and farmed until retirement.

Mrs. Lovig was a member of the Springville United Methodist Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband; one sister, Arlene Fanton; and two brothers, Theodore "Scoots" Strand and Carleton "Sip" Strand.
