Funeral services for Air Force Sgt. Gerald Maschmann, 21, were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, March 27, at the Presbyterian Church in Brooklyn.

Sgt. Maschmann was killed in an auto accident in South Dakota March 21.

The son of Frank and Kathryn Cox Maschmann, he was born in Grinnell Aug. 9, 1951. A graduate of the BGM schools in 1969, he worked for the Rock Island Railroad. He was married to Bonnie Grier of Guernsey April 3, 1971. He entered the Air Force in April of 1971 and had been stationed at Ellsworth Air Force Base, Rapid City, S.D., since August of 1971.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Gerald Frank (Jody); his mother; four brothers, Mike, Kenny, Bud, and Bob; and two sisters, Mrs. Clark (Kathy) Ver Steeg of Grinnell and Linda of Brooklyn.

Military rites were conducted by the Brooklyn American Legion Post at the church, with an escort to the Victor Cemetery. There, military rites were conducted by a unit from Offutt Air Force Base, Neb.
