Services Held

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 11, at the McAninch Chapel in Victor for Frances Mary Maulik, 71, of 1018 East St., Grinnell, who died early Monday morning at Grinnell General Hospital West.

The Rev. Newell Davis, pastor of the United Church of Christ Congregational in Grinnell, officiated at the services. Organist was Mrs. Ireta Daniels.

Burial was in the IOOF Cemetery at Victor.

Miss Maulik taught school at Victor, Carroll, Reinbeck, West Liberty for a total of 26 years. She made her home on the farm with her family until 1927 when she moved to Grinnell.

Miss Maulik was a member of the United Church of Christ Congregational, Rebekah Lodge No. 119 of Grinnell and Pi Lambda Theta.

Survivors include one sister, Mabel Maulik of Grinnell, and several other relatives and friends.
