

Charles Mayo services set

Charles C. Mayo, 74, of the Sheridan community died Friday, April 20, at St. Francis Manor here.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. today at the Sheridan United Methodist Church, with the Rev. William G. Schlobohm, pastor of the church, and the Rev. John Maze of Grinnell officiating.
