Harold W. Meredith, 72, of 221 Depot Ave., Kellogg, died of cancer Saturday, March 1, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

A memorial service is set for 11 a.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell, with the Rev. Jim Seibert of Marshalltown and the Rev. Mike Johnson of Kellogg officiating. Organist will be Ann Buchmeier, and vocalist will be David Edwards. Burial will be in Slagle Cemetery near Newton, following cremation.
