Lola Teresa Hull Meredith, 79, died May 28 at her home in Searsboro.

Memorial services were conducted May 31 at 11:00 a.m. at the Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon, with Rev. Kenneth Santee of Lynnville conducting the service and assisted by Rev. Pat Davis of the Searsboro Church. Burial was at Woodland Cemetery in Lynnville.
