Roy John Meyer, 74, of Kellogg died of cancer Thursday, March 25, at his home.

Graveside services were conducted Monday morning at Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg, with the Rev. Morris Hurd of the Kellogg United Methodist Church officiating. Reese Funeral Home of Newton in charge of arrangements. The body was cremated.
