Rites held for Clyde Miller

KELLOGG (Special)—Clyde Miller, 88, of Kellogg died Friday morning at the Heritage Manor in Newton.

Funeral services for Mr. Miller were conducted Monday afternoon at the Johnson-Reese Chapel in Newton, with the Rev. Carl Klein of the Kellogg Methodist Church officiating. Pallbearers were Steve Miller, Rodney Miller, Robert Miller, Jeff Miller, Ron Barr and Jim Barr, all grandsons.

Burial was at the West Liberty Cemetery, Searsboro. A memorial has been established in Mr. Miller's name.

He was born June 4, 1889, near Searsboro and attended Poweshiek County schools. He was married to Marie Tish on Nov. 23, 1913, in Searsboro, and they moved to Kellogg in 1932.

Mr. Miller was a member of the Christian Church of Kellogg. He served as Kellogg town marshal for several years and was employed at the Midwest Manufacturing factory until his retirement in 1955.

Survivors include his wife, Marie, of Heritage Manor; two sons, Claire Miller of Kellogg and Ivan Miller of Platte City, Neb.; one daughter, Mrs. Owen (Esther) Barr of Newton; 17 grandchildren; 19 great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Orpha Steele of Montezuma. He was preceded in death by his parents; two sons, Lloyd in 1972 and Floyd in 1977; four brothers and one sister.
