

George Miller ^{10/17/71} Rites Wednesday

George Miller, 76, a resident of the Montezuma community for the past two years and formerly of Malcom, died Sunday, Oct. 17, at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

He was born April 25, 1895, in New York state and received his education there. During World War I, he served in the Canadian Army and, following his discharge, he moved to the Los Angeles, Calif., area where he was a gym and physical education instructor for a health club.

He was married to Blanche A. McCain June 19, 1959, at Cedar Rapids. Following their marriage they returned to California, but later moved to Malcom.

Mr. Miller was preceded in death by his wife March 21, 1969. He is survived by his step-daughter, Mrs. Verle Palmer of Newton; and two step-sons, Carrol F. McCain of Malcom and Raib E. McCain of Jefferson City, Mo.

Graveside services for Mr. Miller will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the family lot at the Marengo Cemetery. The Rev. Hugh E. Shiveley, pastor of the First Baptist Church, Grinnell, will officiate.
