

Paul Miller, 56 Dies Suddenly

Paul A. Miller, 56, prominent
Grinnell businessman, died sud-
denly Monday morning at a
local hospital.

Funeral services were held
this afternoon (Thursday) at
the James-Schalinske Funeral
Home. The Rev. Kenneth Poh-

was provided by Mrs. Kathleen
Heffner.
