Samuel Thompson Miller, son of Thompson and Sarah Miller, was born in Virginia, April 2, 1873, and died at Community hospital in Grinnell Dec. 14, 1953, at the age of 80 years, 7 months and 21 days. He had been in failing health for some years.

At the age of 3 years he came with his parents to Iowa and lived on the farm almost his entire life. The last seven years he has resided in Grinnell.

On Feb. 27, 1905 he was married to Carrie M. Hayes, who passed away May 5, 1946. To this union seven children were born: Dorothy Smith, Brooklyn; Perry Miller, Beeman; Lillian Gross, Newburg; Evelyn Peak, Gilman; Robert Miller, Hampton; Willis Miller, Beeman; and Myrtle Prosser who passed away March 12, 1945.

Mr. Miller was a member of the Madison Church of Christ for about 50 years, being baptized by Evang. E. J. Sias. His faith never waivered. He was also an active member of the county Farm Bureau for many years.

He leaves to mourn the loss besides his six children 35 grandchildren; five great grandchildren, three brothers — John and Jesse of Brooklyn and Ira of Hampton, Iowa and one sister, Grace Miller of Brooklyn, and many friends.

Funeral services were conducted by his minister Stephen J. Epler of the Madison church on Wednesday afternoon, Dec.

15. Interment was in the Odd Fellows cemetery, Brooklyn, with six grandsons as pallbearers: Warren and Clinton Smith, Richard Gross, Max and Marvin Miller and Eddie Lee Peak.
