

Frank Mitchell Services Today

Frank Mitchell, 76, of 1133 Hamilton Ave., Grinnell, died Thursday morning (Nov. 1) at Robison Memorial Hospital in Ravenna, Ohio.

The son of Andrew and Lucetta Davis Mitchell, he was born south of Searsboro on Feb. 19, 1897. He attended the Oskaloosa public schools and Tama High School. On July 20, 1918, he was married to Jessie F. Rosenberger in Tama. The couple had two children, Raymond R. Mitchell of Dunn Loring, Va., and a daughter who died in infancy.

Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Mitchell farmed near Searsboro, and for the past six years had made their home in Grinnell. Mr. Mitchell was a member of the Montezuma American Legion Post No. 169 for 55 years.

He is survived by his wife and son; two grandchildren, Dennis and Janet Mitchell of Dunn Loring, Va.; a brother, Raymond Mitchell of New Sharon; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Funeral services for Mr. Mitchell were held at 1 p.m. today (Nov. 1) at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Delano Cunningham, pastor of the Lynnville Friends Church, officiating. Organist was Mrs. Willard Heffner, and flower-bearers were Mrs. Afton Gause, Mrs. William Gray, and Mrs. Leo Watson.
