Saturday Funeral Services Set For Fred Mithelman

Fred Mithelman, age 83, of 1802 8th Avenue, died Wednesday evening at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be Saturday afternoon at 2:00 p.m. at the Trinity Lutheran church. Rev. John Pannkuk will officiate, and interment will be in the Trinity Lutheran cemetery. A prayer service will be held at the James Schalinske Funeral Home at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday.

The son of Theodore and Wilhelmina Topp Mithelman, he was born on November 20, 1880, at Kellogg, Iowa. As a youngster his parents moved to the Ewart community, where he received his education and in 1895 they moved to the Sheridan community.

He was united in marriage to Lena Lidtka on December 2, 1913, at the home of Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Deedrick of rural Malcom. On December 2, 1964, they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary. Following their marriage they farmed in the Malcom community until their retirement in 1944, when they moved to Ginnell.

He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church, being confirmed on April 3, 1898, and also a member of the Trinity Brotherhood.

He is survived by his wife, Lena, a daughter, Mrs. Gail (Elsie) Young of Ginnell; two sons, LeRoy and Claire, both of Ginnell; a brother, Elmer Mithelman of Coggan, Iowa; 7 grandchildren, and 2 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, 4 brothers and one sister.
