

Funeral Services Held For Joshua Main, 84

Funeral services were held Monday, Sept. 14, at the Searsboro Community Church for Joshua Main, 84, who died Sept. 11 at Marshalltown where he had made his home for the past five years.

Dr. James Delahooke, pastor of the First United Methodist Church of Marshalltown, officiated at the services. Burial was in the IOOF Cemetery at Searsboro.

Mr. Main was born Aug. 25, 1886 in a log cabin on a farm near Searsboro. He was one of 11 children born to Aaron and Martha Main. With the exception of the past five years when he lived in Marshalltown and two years spent in South Dakota where he homesteaded a claim near Wall, he lived his entire life in the Searsboro area.

On Dec. 2, 1908, Mr. Main married Elizabeth Davis. She preceded him in death on May 20, 1909. On Nov. 15, 1916, he married Marie Brignon who survives.

Surviving in addition to his wife are one son, Kenneth of Marshalltown; three grandchildren; and one sister, Mrs. Cora Bailey of Greeley, Colo.
