Albert J. Moredock, 81, of Newton, formerly of Grinnell, died of cancer Friday, Jan. 31, at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Raleigh Gordon, interim pastor of the Newton First Baptist Church, officiating. Burial was in Newton Memorial Park Cemetery.

The son of Charles and Mary McCauley Moredock, he was born July 3, 1910, in Gilford, Ind. He received his education in Mingo and Perry schools. He was married to Esther J. Hockey Nov. 22, 1945, in Newton.
