Edna E. Morgan, 94, of Flossmoor, Ill., died Sunday at Applewood Manor in Matteson, Ill.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. James P. Russell, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating. Organist will be Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers will be members of the family, with burial at the Union Cemetery, Newton.

The daughter of James and Mary Ellen Frey Patton, she was born June 22, 1885, at Macedonia. She was graduated from Macedonia High School in 1930 and later taught school in that community and in Fort Dodge.

She attended the Illinois Training School for Nurses in Chicago and graduated in 1923. Following her training, she worked as a nurse in Utah and Colorado.

She was married to George L. Morgan in 1926, and the couple farmed near Kellogg until 1950 when they moved to Grin-

nell. While living here, she was employed as a nurse at the former St. Francis Hospital and at Friendship Manor. She had lived with her son, James, since 1974. She was a member of the Methodist Church and the Order of the Easter Star.

Mrs. Morgan is survived by her children, James P. Morgan of Flossmoor, Ill., and John L. Morgan of Piedmont, Calif., and six grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband in 1956, her parents, one sister, and three brothers.
