*Mrs. Milo Morgan.*

Susannah Robertson was born in Oneida county, N. Y., July 13, 1833. When 13 years of age she moved to Columbus, Ohio, where she was converted and joined the Methodist church. Thence she moved in 1852 at the age of 18 to Lincoln township, Poweshiek county, Iowa. Here she was married to Milo Morgan in 1857—the first couple to be married in that township after the organization of the county. For a time they made their home in Washington township where Mrs. Morgan was left with four children when her husband enlisted in August, 1862. In 1891, they moved to Grinnell, where they have since made their home.

To Mr. and Mrs. Morgan were born ten children, nine of whom and her husband survive her. The children are: A. J. Morgan, of Stuart, Iowa; Mrs. George Champlin, of Grinnell; J. D. Morgan, of Grinnell, with whom the father and mother have made their home and who has been unremitting in his care; H. W. Morgan, of Marshall town; Mrs. Dota Baskirk, of Elmwood Neb.; Garrett Morgan, deceased; Mrs. S. A. Tish, of Jacob; Mrs. E. H. Reavis of Grinnell; C. H. Morgan, living west of Grinnell; Mrs. Louis Baskirk, of Grinnell. A brother, Horace Robertson, the only one remaining of a large family, is left to mourn her decease.

Mrs. Morgan's death last Sunday night closed a life rich in good works. She was always active in Sunday school work in her early life and her every day life showed her Christian character.

The funeral will be held tomorrow morning at 10:30 o'clock, at the home on South Broad Street.
