

## Mrs. Morrison rites Tuesday

Julia E. (Lulu) Morrison, 99, died late Thursday, May 2, at Friendship Manor, where she had lived since 1973.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Robert C. Smith of the Grinnell First Baptist Church officiating. Organist will be Edward H. Bohstedt, and pallbearers will be Harold Andes, Harold Brown, Donovan Evans, Laverne Morrison, William R. Morrison and Gail Wheeler. Burial will be at Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom.

The daughter of William Robert and Lucinda Smith Scandrett, she was born Aug. 4, 1885, at Avoca. She came with her family to a farm near Grinnell and attended Grinnell High School and Cedar Falls Teachers College. She taught for eight years in rural schools before her marriage to John T. Morrison on Dec. 17, 1919. The couple farmed southwest of

Malcom until Mr. Morrison's death in 1950, and in 1951 she came to Grinnell and lived at 508 Fifth Ave.

Mrs. Morrison was a lifelong member of the Grinnell First Baptist Church and was a member of the Harmony Ladies Aid.

She is survived by one son, George M. Morrison of the Sheridan community, seven grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, and three sisters: Bernice Shettfield of Russell, Minn.; Dorothy Farmer of Grinnell and Alice Jones of Fremont.

She was preceded in death by her husband; one daughter, Elizabeth A. (Betty) Ward; one grandson; a sister, Esther Carter; and a brother, Milton Scandrett.
