**Frank Morrow
Was Native Of
Barnes City**

Memorial services for Frank Morrow were conducted at 2 p.m. from the Christian church in Barnes City by the Rev. William Morehouse. Mrs. William Landstrom played the musical selections and accompanied Mrs. John Grubb as she sang "The Lord's Prayer".

Interment was in the Barnes City cemetery under direction of the Steffy Funeral Home. Casket bearers were Fred Curry, Alfred Graham, Gale Riggs, Elmo Chandler, Harold Lester and Harold Riggs.

Frank, son of Rilda and Jacob Morrow, was born in Barnes City Aug. 30, 1883, and died in Mahaska hospital, Oskaloosa, Feb. 24, at 79 years of age.

He worked in the Barnes City Tile Factory and later, became its manager.

In 1906, he was united in marriage with Bertalin Grubb. Their entire married life of 57 years has been spent in Barnes City.

In 1907, he affiliated with the Baptist church, south of Barnes City.

He worked for several years as a filling station attendant, but for the past five years, he has been confined to his home by illness, where he has been tenderly cared for by his wife.

He is survived by his wife and one sister, Mrs. Neil Cruzon, Davenport, other relatives and many friends.
