BERNARD E. MULHERN

Funeral services for Bernard E. Mulhern, 98, of the Iowa Veterans Home in Marshalltown, formerly of 611 E. 3rd St. S., were held at 2 p.m. Saturday, May 23, 1987, at the Reese Chapel in Newton.

The Rev. William Calhoun, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, conducted the services. Burial was in Sugar Grove Cemetery.

He died Wednesday, May 20, at the Iowa Veterans Home of a heart condition.

Survivors are a number of nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, Nellie, in 1985, a brother and a number of half sisters and half-brothers.

Mr. Mulhern, an Army veteran of World War I, was a retired Maytag Company employee and had farmed in Poweshiek County.

The son of Edward and Irene Eiton Mulhern, he was born Aug. 22, 1888 in Iowa County.

He was married to Nellie Leeper Feb. 21, 1924 in Newton.

Mr. Mulhern had moved to a farm near Maicom following his retirement from the Maytag Company and later lived in Florida for 29 years prior to moving to Newton in 1976.
