Cleo Mullins services held

Cleo Mullins, 60, of Knoxville died Wednesday, Jan. 12, at the Pella Community Hospital. He had been ill with cancer for the past two years.

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a.m. Saturday at Bybee & Davis Funeral Home in Knoxville, with the Rev. Russell Farrell officiating. Burial was at Hazelwood Cemetery in Grinnell.

The son of Jesse A. and Myrtle Abott Mullins, he was born Feb. 11, 1922, in Unionville, Mo. He was married to Colleen DeHart on Oct. 13, 1942, at Lancaster, Mo. In September of that year he was inducted into the U.S. Navy, serving until

Oct. 3, 1945.

Following his discharge, the couple lived in Grinnell until moving to Knoxville in 1967 where he was the assistant manager at Moorman's Feeds' Knoxville plant.

Survivors include his wife, Colleen; one son, Dr. Michael Mullins of Silver Springs, Md.; one granddaughter, Erein; his mother, Myrtle Mullins of Grinnell; two brothers, Edwin Mullins of Phoenix, Ariz., and James Mullins of Grinnell; and three sisters, Dorothy Hill of Louisville, Ky., Mary Tufte of Arizona and Leta Rasmussen of Nevada.
