Roy S. Mushrush Sr. of 601 Tenth Ave., Grinnell, died early Wednesday at St. Francis Manor.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, followed by graveside rites at 11 a.m. Saturday at Forest Hill Cemetery, Duluth, Minn. Masonic services will be conducted at 7 p.m. Thursday at the Smith Funeral Home.

The son of Lewis K. and Maude Estella Carnahan Mushrush, he was born June 17, 1893, at Fosterville, Ohio. He attended schools in Toronto, Ohio, then received a degree in civil engineering from Valpariso University in 1915.

He was married to Marjorie McMillan on Jan. 5, 1916, in Duluth, where he was employed as a city engineer.

The family also lived in Emmetsburg, Cedar Rapids and Iowa City before moving to Grinnell in 1943.

Mr. Mushrush worked here as a professional engineer and land surveyor. He was active in Masonic organizations, becoming a 50-year member in May 1980. He was a member of Hermon Masonic Lodge No. 273, the Royal Arch Masons No. 143, and Beulah Chapter No. 147, Order of Eastern Star, in Grinnell. He was also a member of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, which he had served as treasurer.

Survivors include his son, Roy S. Mushrush Jr. of Brielle, N.J.; two grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and a sister, Hazel Grimm of Steubenville, Ohio. He was preceded in death by his wife in 1974.
