

Mattie McCartney Buried Thursday

Funeral services for Mrs. Mattie McCartney were held Thursday afternoon, Oct. 28, at the Steffy Funeral Home with the Rev. G. R. Dieken officiating.

Interment was in the Barnes City Cemetery with Adrian Sams, Dwight Strong, Madison Sams, Jr., Bill Ver Beek, Harold Roovaart and Bud Baird serving as casket bearers.

Mattie, daughter of Mary

and Octave Reed, was born near Oskaloosa, Iowa, on Feb. 13, 1888, and died on Tuesday, Oct. 26. She was 77 years old.

In her youth she attended rural school and became a member of the Baptist Church.

She was married to Guy Minner and to this union four children were born, all of whom died in infancy. They lived on a farm south of Barnes City until Mr. Minner's death in 1952.

She later married Allen McCartney and they resided in Montezuma. Mr. McCartney passed away in 1960. A short time later she fell, breaking her hip and she has been cared for in nursing homes since then.

Survivors include two sisters-in-law and several nieces and nephews.
