Mac Roger McClure, 30, of Williamsburg, a native of Grinnell, died Wednesday, Jan. 15, in a traffic accident in Towa County east of Millersburg.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Rev. George Salnave of the First Presbyterian Church of Montezuma officiating.
