Albert McKeag, son of John McKeag and his wife Helen Putman, was born on a farm near Montezuma February 3, 1881 and lived almost all of his life on farms in the Montezuma and Malcom areas. In 1950 he and his wife returned to Malcom.

Mr. McKeag was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church, Malcom.

He was united in marriage to Susie Cowell on July 3, 1904. Two children, Adrian and Lois, were born to this union. He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Ella, Mrs. Art Hubbard. Survivors include his widow; two sisters, Mrs. Sadie Blaine of Thornburg, and Mrs. Hattie Mikesell of Delta; three brothers, William of Clinton, Bert of Birmingham and Ben of Montezuma; his children, Adrian of Grinnell and Lois, Mrs. Frank Ferneau of Malcom; nine grandchildren; many neices and nephews and a host of friends.

Mr. McKeag had enjoyed reasonably good health until Thursday morning when he suffered a stroke. He was taken to a Grinnell hospital where he passed away Tuesday morning. He had reached the advanced age of 75 years, 7 months and 8 days.

The Rev. Donald Loots of St. Johns Lutheran, Grinnell conducted the funeral services at the Malcom Presbyterian Church Friday afternoon. Interment was at the Montezuma Cemetery.
