

S. Sgt. Larry McKeag Killed in Car Crash

Funeral services were held at the Presbyterian church Monday afternoon for Staff Sgt. Larry McKeag of Brooklyn who was fatally injured last Wednesday night in an auto accident near Westmoreland, N. Y.

Sgt. McKeag, 27, died in a New York hospital after his auto struck a bridge abutment. The son of Mr. and Mrs. Walter McKeag, Sgt. McKeag, was a 1961 graduate of BGM high school and had been in the Air Force for more than eight years. He was stationed at Griffiss Air Force Base in Rome, N. Y. at the time of the fatal accident.

Rev. Richard Menzel officiated at the services and burial was in the IOOF cemetery. Casketbearers and color guard were Air Force personnel from Offutt Air Force

Base, Omaha.
