

Miss Ida McKee, Monte Teacher Many Years, Dies

Miss Ida McKee, teacher at Montezuma for many years, died Monday at Montezuma following an illness of several months. She was 88 years old.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon from Steffy Funeral Home in Montezuma.

A teacher for more than half a century, Miss McKee taught algebra at Newton for 30 years from 1903 until 1933, and had also taught at Victor and Marenco in addition to Montezuma.

Since her retirement, she had been managing the family farms in the Montezuma community.

She was born June 19, 1866, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edward R. McKee and attended Iowa State College, the University of Colorado and the University of Wisconsin.
