**Hartwick Resident,
W. McLennan, Dies**

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Oct. 26, in Hartwick for Walter Scott (Waldo) McLennan, lifelong Hartwick area resident and former Hartwick mayor, who died Saturday (Oct. 23) at a Belle Plaine convalescent home at the age of 87.

The son of Lochlan and Ladosea Plumb McLennan, Mr. McLennan was born April 9, 1884 on the McLennan farm north of Hartwick where he resided until 1944 when he moved to Hartwick. He had been active in many community and church organizations including the Hartwick orchestra; the Hartwick Congregational Church where he taught Sunday school and was a church board member for many years, and the County Farm Bureau where he was a charter member. As a historian he had completed and published a book about Hartwick and vicinity and had also published a book of some of his poems.

Survivors include a son, Harold; a daughter, June Hultman; 11 grandchildren; 10 great-grandchildren; one brother and two sisters.
