Herman, son of Mary and Oscar McNeal, was born in Montezuma Nov. 18, 1901 and died in Mahaska county hospital Nov. 4 at 61 years of age. He began school in Monte and was graduated from the Osceola, Nebr., high school.

Jan. 2, 1943 he was united in marriage with Vivian Phillips and they established their home in Philadelphia, Pa., where he was employed. In 1946, following World War II, in which he saw Army service, they moved to Seattle, Wash.

The past two weeks Mr. and Mrs. McNeal have been visiting friends and relatives in this area. Besides his wife he is survived by three brothers, Ben of Geneva; John of Grinnell and William of Oskaloosa; two sisters, Mrs. Jessie Whitaker, Seattle, and Mrs. Mary Stanford, Montezuma, other relatives and many friends.
