Claude V. Naylor Dies Here Monday Services Friday

Claude V. Naylor passed away Monday evening at his home at 1126 Ann St. here. 6-17-63.

The son of William H. and Mary Sarah Vesul Naylor, he was born on September 7, 1892 at Bluepoint Community south-east of Grinnell. When a youngster, his parents moved to Greene county where he received his education and in 1898 his family returned to Grinnell.
