HENRY FRED NEISTER

Henry Fred Neister was born June 9, 1893 at Dillsboro, Indiana the son of Henry Fred Neister and Sophia Viet Neister.

He attended public schools in Indiana and the Presbyterian church and in his youth came to Iowa where he has resided ever since.
