

## Cecil Neitzel

Cecil A. Neitzel, 75, of Brooklyn died of a heart attack Wednesday, Sept. 13, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

No services are planned. A reception will be held at the home of Herb and Beverly Frisch, 1345 Jersey Lane, Waterloo, from 2 to 4 p.m. this Saturday.

He was the son of William and Viola Richards Neitzel and was born Jan. 20, 1920, in Guernsey. He was a 1938 graduate of Guernsey High School. He served with the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II.

He was married to Sue Wilson Jan. 29, 1945, in Hull, England. The couple lived in several communities before moving to Waterloo in 1949. Mr. Neitzel was employed as a supervisor at Waterloo Industries. He retired in 1982, and the couple moved to Holiday Lake near Brooklyn in 1994.

Surviving are his wife; two children, Paul Neitzel and Beverly Frisch, both of Waterloo; one sister, Norma Jean Hatch of New Raymar, Colo.; and two grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Dale and Marian.

A Cecil A. Neitzel Memorial Fund has been established. The Smith Funeral Home of Grinnell is handling arrangements.
